

## **TENNIS RULES**

### **General Conditions for Tennis Play:**

1. The tennis courts are available for play between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
2. The tennis courts are for the use of Wildwood at Meadow Gate residents and their guests only.
3. Playing time is limited to one hour for singles matches and one hour and thirty minutes for doubles matches. If no other players are waiting for courts, playing time can be extended until other players show up to play.
4. Proper tennis attire and appropriate tennis shoes must be worn within the fenced area of the courts. Playing barefoot, in street shoes, black-soled shoes or muddy shoes is prohibited. Shirts are required.
5. Only tennis players and tennis equipment are allowed within the fenced court area.
6. Members must accompany all guests onto the courts and at least one member must be part of the play. Residents are responsible for the conduct, dress and action of their guests. Alta sponsored events are an exception to this.
7. Parents are required to familiarize their children with all tennis rules. Parents are responsible for their children whether the parents are on the courts or not.
8. Members or their families who violate these tennis rules are subject to suspension of tennis privileges for a period of time to be determined by the tennis committee.

### **General Tennis Rules and Etiquette:**

1. Food, smoking, chewing gum or glass containers are not permitted within the fenced court area. Beverages in unbreakable containers are permitted.
2. No individual player may occupy a court if other players are waiting to play.
3. If a single or doubles player is replaced, the time limit shall be the limit applicable to the original players, if previous arrivals are waiting for a court.
4. No games other than tennis may be played on the courts.
5. Loud or annoying radios or boisterous conduct are not allowed. Please turn down cell phones, pagers or other devices that may distract other players.
6. No pets, bicycles, skateboards, skates or other vehicles are allowed on the courts.
7. Do not abuse the nets, court surface or equipment. Report any damage to the tennis committee.

8. Report any malicious conduct observed in the court area to the Homeowners Association Tennis Committee. Acts of destruction or vandalism will not be tolerated and will result in suspension of tennis privileges for a length of time as determined by the tennis committee. Further, the full cost of repairing the destruction or vandalism will be the responsibility of the specific member. If the minor child of a member commits such destruction or vandalism, the full cost of repairing the damage will be the responsibility of the minor's family. The minor shall also be subject to the suspension of privileges.
9. Each resident is responsible for picking up and properly disposing of his or her litter.
10. Please wait until play has stopped before crossing behind other players or retrieving a ball. Return balls to other players whenever possible.
11. Avoid loud conversations, abusive language, or any other actions that may distract other players. This also applies to non-players immediately outside the fence.
12. Non-players are not allowed in the fenced court area.
13. Keep court gates closed during play.
14. Consumption of alcohol is a matter of personal preference. Containers of alcoholic beverages should be kept as inconspicuous as possible.
15. No loitering is allowed.
16. Unless you are renting the clubhouse, the parking lot closes at 10:00 p.m.
